



ECVO Abstract submission guidelines for authors

Deadline for abstract submission is 06 January 2019.

Please prepare the abstract according to the following guidelines:

All abstracts must be written in **correct English and must be proof read before submission.**

1. The abstract must be typed in Arial, 11 pt, with single spacing.
The abstract body (not including the title, author(s) or affiliations) **must not exceed 250 words.**
An example of an abstract construction is shown in the abstract form below.
2. The title of the study must be written in **capital letters.**
3. All authors must be listed, separated by commas.
The authors' institutional affiliations must be indicated with superscript numbers.
The institutions, likewise numbered, must be separated by semicolons.
4. The abstract must include the headings **Purpose, Methods, Results** and **Conclusions** in boldfaced type.
The heading **Support** (in boldfaced type) can be included if it is applicable.

ABSTRACTS THAT DO NOT FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES WILL BE REJECTED WITHOUT REVIEW.

EXAMPLE of Abstract:

TITLE (in capital letters)

AB Author¹, CD Author¹ & EF Author²

Department of This and That, University of Nowhere, Norway¹; School of Something, University of Somewhere, Sweden²

Purpose: State the aim of the study or the question the study was intended to answer, e.g. why you decided to perform a survey of an ocular disease in a breed. **Methods:** Describe the experimental design and assay methods or methods of examination employed in the study. Include, if relevant, a description of control and treatment groups or number and signalment of cases. Include, if relevant, sample preparation, assay protocols and statistical methods. **Results:** Report the data resulting from the study, e.g. clinical and histopathological findings in a group of patients. **Conclusions:** Interpret the results and indicate their significance. **Support:** List financial sponsors and scientific contributors that have been of major importance to the accomplishment of the study. This heading can be left out, if not applicable.

EXAMPLE of CV: Presenting author's name, title, position, institution (max. 1 page!)

(The CV will be needed by the session chair to give a brief introduction prior to your presentation.)
